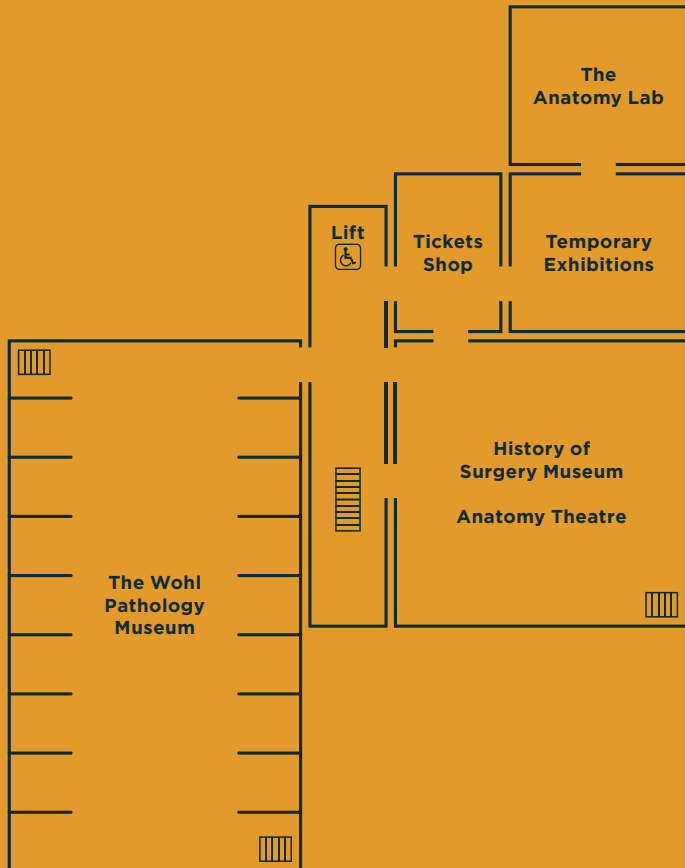

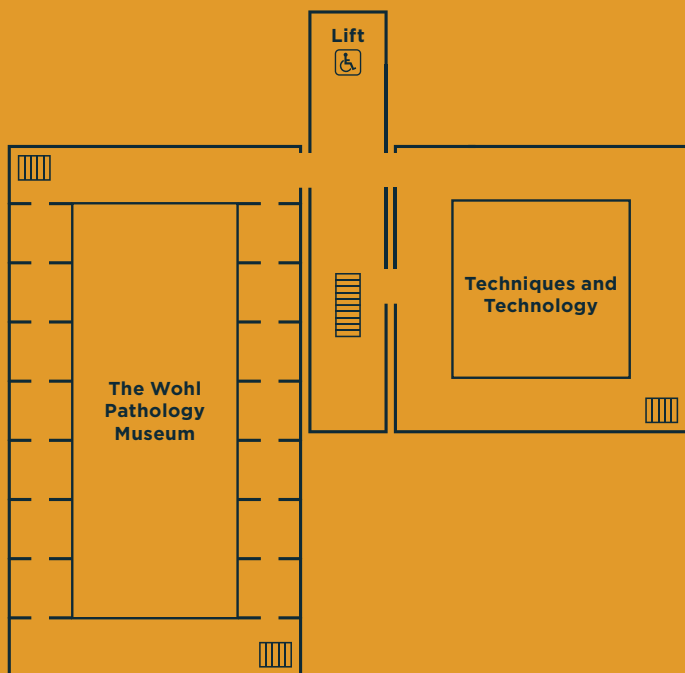


MUSEUM MAP

UPPER GALLERIES



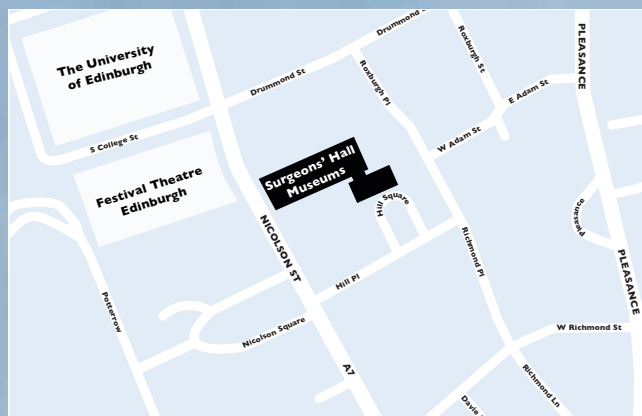
Fully accessible toilets are located in the basement
